## **Job Descriptions:**

Very **strong English** is required for most positions. Intermediate English is required for Room Attendant and Steward positions. The St. Regis Deer Valley requires that all employees pass a **pre-employment drug and background test.** 

#### Housekeeping

**Room Attendants** clean and reset guest bedroom and bathroom areas according to established standards. They organize and stock the cleaning cart and organize linen closets on floors assigned.

**House Attendants** are in charge of stripping beds and taking soiled linens from guest rooms, vacuuming hallways and guest rooms, cleaning carpet spots, restocking linen closets, cleaning service areas, sending dirty linen to be washed and receiving clean linen, and help room attendants.

**Public Area Attendants** will be cleaning all the food & beverage and public areas including the restaurant. They vacuum and dust public areas, polish woods, refresh flowers, and mop floors. They also clean public bathrooms, restock bathrooms, and clean back of house associate areas.

## Food & Beverage

**Server Assistants** assist servers in the restaurant and bar. They deliver food to tables, clean and reset tables, and pour water.





**Hosts** are responsible for greeting guests, helping customers get seated, managing reservations, and keeping the host station clean. You should also be prepared to help out where needed and in general help keep the restaurant clean and running smoothly.

**Pool Servers** serve food and beverages at the pool. Very strong English is required. This is an outside job. You will be on your feet and in the sun.

#### Stewarding

**Stewards** wash dishes and pots, fill requisitions from restaurant, help out during private dining & banquets. They also mop floors and take care of the garbage.

### Spa/Recreation

**Pool/Leisure Attendants** greet guests and provide service for the pool tools and recreational activities such as yoga setups, hikes, & lawn games. Must be 21 years of age. This is an outside role.

**Spa Attendants** clean and restock spa locker rooms, greet guests, explain locker room services, restock water, and fresh fruit, etc.

**Work Hours:** You should expect to work an average of **32 - 40 hours/week** throughout the summer, with overtime available during the busiest part of the season.

Work Start Dates: You should plan your U.S. arrival so you can begin working May 15 - June 15.

**Work Finish Dates:** We are looking for candidates who can finish working **September 15 – September 30.** You should be as upfront and honest as possible about your work finish date. It is customary in the U.S. to give at least two weeks' notice of your final day of work.

**Uniform:** Employees should maintain a neat and clean appearance at all times. A full set of requirements will be provided to you by The St. Regis prior to arrival. You will be required to bring black trousers and black shoes.

**Interviews:** We will interview all candidates individually. If you are applying with a friend or partner, please inform us during your interview.

**Housing Information:** The St. Regis Deer Valley **does not provide housing**, but apartment housing is available in Park City. The St. Regis will assist in grouping Exchange Visitors together to assist in securing housing. Housing fees are paid directly to the apartment complex. Additional details on securing housing will follow any job offer.





**Area Description:** Park City lies east of Salt Lake City in the western state of Utah. Framed by the craggy Wasatch Range, it's bordered by the Deer Valley Resort and the huge Park City Mountain Resort, both known for their ski slopes. Utah Olympic Park, to the north, hosted the 2002 Winter Olympics and is now predominantly a training facility. In town, Main Street is lined with buildings built during a 19th-century silver mining boom. Explore cultural sites in the cities of Salt Lake City and Denver, and visit the numerous National Parks and Forests within a short bus ride or flight.
