There are no cooking facilities in dorm rooms. You will also be provided with free laundry and detergent, shampoo, conditioner, soap, and lotion. Linens and towels are available by request.




<u>Uniform:</u>

Movies at the Drive Inn Movie theatre, a popular American pastime and favorite of all the locals! The Living Desert Zoo & Garden State Park.



Employees are expected to provide their own linens for their twin size beds and towels for the bathroom. The common area will have a seating area, a full size refrigerator, stove, microwave and washer/ dryer and a TV. There is outside seating with a BBQ area.


Area Description:
