

Management creates the schedule for each week. Employees are given 40 hours a week with two days off. If you wish to work more hours or take time off, please request this in advance with your manager. Hours are consistent but if we do have bad weather, we close the outside seating area of our restaurant. Typically, we do not send people home but may assign them to another section of the restaurant. The schedule is posted by the employee time clock as well as emailed out to the staff, weekly.

Description

Housing and meals are provided for approximately \$110 per week. You will be living in a dormitory within walking distance of the restaurant. You will be living in a rustic setting, 4 people per bunkroom. You will share a dorm style bathroom with all the students on your floor (same gender). You are required to keep your living space clean according to National Park standards; rooms are inspected weekly. Men and women live on separate floors. There is no "couples" housing. Meals (cooked by the dorm cook) are included. There are no cooking facilities in dorm rooms. Rent also includes free laundry and detergent, shampoo, conditioner, soap, and lotion. Linens and towels are available by request. The dorm is located in Acadia National Park, about 8 miles from the town of Bar Harbor, Maine.
