

#### Description

Housing is provided on a seasonal basis. We do not provide "weekly" beds. The cost is \$2750, however, all employees will receive a \$500 employee discount bringing the rent per season to \$2250 plus a \$250 refundable security deposit.

\$500 is due and invoiced before arrival. \$250 is refundable and returned on or before December 1st via PayPal as long as the unit is returned in the same manner it was received and the original housing keys are returned. The other \$250 is applied directly to the \$2250 balance of seasonal rent due at time of arrival. The remaining \$2000 is deducted from payroll in installments of \$200 for the first 10 weeks of employment.

#### **Housing Deposit Refund**

\$250 is refundable and returned on or before December 1st via PayPal as long as the unit is returned in the same manner it was received and the original housing keys are returned. The other \$250 is applied directly to the \$2,250 balance of seasonal rent due at time of arrival. The remaining \$2000 is deducted from payroll in installments of \$200 for the first 10 weeks of employment.
