
Uniform or Dress Code Requirements

Work Schedule Details

Employees receive their schedule from their department's scheduling manager. Schedules will be posted where it can be accessed and reviewed by employees.

A minimum of 35 hours per week must be worked, weekends, nights and holiday shifts are required and schedules may be adjusted during holiday weekends.

Any additional time off must be requested for approval with a minimum of 2 weeks notice. If there are any shift delays or cancelations due to inclement weather employees will be notified via email prior to their shift.

After Labor Day Casino Pier operates on a reduced scheduled (weekends only) until Columbus Day in October, allowing for students to travel during the week.

Meals Included

Employees receive a discounted employee menu at the Pier Grill and Dockside restaurants while working. If employees decide to to order items not included in the employee discounted menu, they will receive a 25% discount on their order.

Paycheck Deductions (in addition to taxes)

Employees staying in our housing will have their \$150.00 weekly rent reduced from their weekly paychecks.

The town of Seaside Heights has a noise ordinance that goes into affect at 11pm. The town also requires that residents put out garbage/recycling cans after sunset for morning pickup, and that the bins are removed from the sidewalk shortly after they have been emptied. Residents will be ticketed by the town of Seaside Heights and are responsible for paying any fines incurred. Casino Pier does not permit overnight guests, parties or underage drinking on our properties. Ride Operator

Position Description

Ride Operators are responsible for displaying a professional, pleasant attitude to all customers. Job duties for this position may include starting and stopping amusement park rides, assisting guests on rides, and giving safety instructions to guests. Students may be expected to work in other areas of the store as directed by management. Your employer may ask you to perform other duties related to your job type. What do you need to apply? Have a positive upbeat attitude, a smiling face, be outgoing, and have a willingness to learn. We'll do the rest by training you along the way. You'll be trained for specific ride operations as well as safety inspections and emergency procedures.

My day as an operator will include:

- Following all safety precautions as well as complying with all Casino Beach Pier, LLC policies and procedures.
- Respectfully interacting with guests in a positive, fun and safe way.
- Safely performing job duties that are explained during comprehensive ride operator and safety trainings.
- Accurately checking heights for every rider and enforcing accompanying rider policies.
- Collecting an admission fee (credits or wristbands) for every rider.
- Being responsible for the safe daily operation of rides and attractions.
- Safely assisting guests on and off the ride/attractions.
- Assuring all aspects of the ride cycle comply with normal safety procedures.
- Maintaining a clean and safe working environment for guests and team members.
- Being rotated throughout multiple rides and working well with coworkers to safely operate the ride.

Fast Food Crew

Position Description

Fast Food Crews are responsible for cash register responsibilities, cleaning, cooking, sandwich preparation, and the opening and closing of the restaurant. Your employer may ask you to perform other duties related to your job type. If you have questions or concerns about this, please contact InterExchange.

<u>SWT Regulations</u> prohibit employment In positions declared hazardous to youth by the Secretary of Labor at Subpart E of <u>29 CFR part 570</u>. This includes the operation of deli slicers, including setting-up, adjusting, repairing, or oiling such machines or the cleaning of such machines or the individual parts or attachments of such machines, regardless of the product being processed by these machines (including, for example, the slicing in a retail delicatessen of meat, poultry, seafood, bread, vegetables, or cheese, etc.).

Additional Description

Food Service employees are required to perform various food and beverage related tasks including:

- cooking or preparing food items according to procedures or recipes.
- Placing food items on serving plates or dishes along with required condiments and utensils to present to guests.
- Preparing cold drinks, warm drinks and other non-alcoholic beverages.
- All items must be prepared quickly and accurately ensuring no waste and must be in accordance with production, portion requirements, and quality standards.
- All of the above must always be performed while maintaining a safe and sanitary work environment.
- Food Service employees may be responsible for using a point-of-sale system to accurately to take orders and collect payment. Payments may be in the form of cash or credit. You must be familiar with American currency in order to accept payment and provide change (coins/bills) as well as complete credit card transactions when necessary.
- All Food Service employees will be responsible for maintaining and cleaning all food service areas including preparation tables, equipment, dishes, floors, supply areas, refrigerators, coolers, sales areas, and guests areas (tables, chairs, serving lines, condiment stands, etc.)

Requirements

Demonstrate a high level of customer service. Respond to and take appropriate action to resolve concerns and complaints of guests. -Keep supervisor/ manager informed of situations relating to facility operation, patron complaints or concerns, accidents, emergency situations, damages and potential safety hazards. -Attend departmental and team meetings as well as participate in all training courses. -Perform all duties in a safe manner. -Employees may be asked to move to different locations or job assignments within the property, as needed. Other duties may be assigned.

Lifeguard

10 Positions

\$15.13 /hour **35 hours** /week

Position Description

Lifeguards are responsible for ensuring a safe environment for swimmers. You must be able to recognize and react properly in emergency situations. You will check and maintain specific chemical levels in the pool and operate the pool filtration system. Additional duties may include but are not limited to cleaning the pool and surrounding areas, cleaning the restrooms, removing trash and enforcing facility rules and gate control. Your employer may ask you to perform other duties related to your job type. If you have questions or concerns about this, please contact InterExchange.

Additional Description

This is NOT your typical beach lifeguard job! In our Waterpark, most of our water is shallow. You don't need to be a super strong swimmer, nor do you have to run miles along the beach to train! All we ask is you like to be outdoors, like to wear hats and sunglasses, and are not afraid of being in the water and getting wet. We will train you to do the rest!!! If you want to get paid to have fun, get a great tan, and make a difference in people's lives, then read on and put in your application today!!! Lifeguarding/Attendant is a fun and memorable experience with tons of privileges and rewards. Lifeguards are among the few summer jobs where you can truly make a difference in someone else's life, as well as your own. As a Lifeguard you will be responsible for Attendant responsibilities as well as Lifeguard responsibilities. These include guest safety in pool and run-out areas, as well as checking heights, ensuring guests abide by the rules and maintain safe guest flow at the slides. You are expected to maintain a proactive scanning pattern at all times, and remain in a rescue ready position at all times.

Requirements

Shallow Certification. With this Certification you will be able to guard all areas in the park. In order to acquire this certification, you must: Swim 50 yards continuously and in a comfortable fashion. Swim down 5.5 feet, retrieve a brick and swim it to the wall.

Physical Demands

Lifeguards will be working outdoors, often in bright sun and will be exposed to hot, humid conditions, cold rainy temperatures, as well as chlorine fumes or airborne chemical particles. Employees are occasionally exposed to moving mechanical parts and vibration. The noise level is usually loud. All workers will perform physical activities that require moving one's whole body, such as lifting, balancing, climbing, and stooping or bending. These activities also require considerable use of the arms and legs. Lifeguards will be required to stand for long periods of time and may be required to sit for extended periods of time on an elevated chair. Lifeguards will be rotated between various positions/slides which are built at various heights above ground level. Will be required to lift, push, or carry objects weighing up to 25 pounds frequently and occasionally lift and/or move more than 100 pounds. Lifeguards may be moved between various departments as needed.

Games Attendant

10 Positions

\$15.13 /hour **35 hours** /week

Position Description

Game Attendants are responsible for working inside of an arcade or booth, promoting games to guests, collecting/dispensing tickets, prizes and money sales, assisting guests as needed with questions and troubleshooting game issues. Your employer may ask you to perform other duties related to your job type. If you have questions or concerns about this, please contact InterExchange.

Additional Description

Step on up! As a Games employee you are the life of the boardwalk! As an attendant will be working one of our classic boardwalk games, attracting guests to your game and assuring they have an unforgettable experience while playing to win the grand prize.

Requirements:

- Must be able to project your voice out to potential guests and attract attention to your game.
- Basic math skills are required for currency exchanges.
- Must be able to explain the rules of how each game is played as well as the prize structure (small, medium, large) to our guests.
- Every employee will be responsible for maintaining and replenishing merchandise in midway games and they must maintain cleanliness of the game area and merchandise prizes.

Physical Demands:

- Unloading incoming boxes of stock which may weigh 20-25 lbs.
- Employees will be required to stand for long periods of time (6 8 hours).
- Specific vision abilities are required for this job including but not limited to: close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and the ability to adjust focus.
- Employees will be working indoors/outdoors and are exposed to all types of weather. You may be exposed to loud sensory noises throughout the day.

Attractions Attendant

5 Positions

\$15.13 /hour **35 hours** /week

Position Description

Attractions Attendants focus on the safe operation of the attractions while consistently providing outstanding customer service to all guests and coworkers. You should work to promote a fun and friendly environment. Position will be working outdoors in all weather conditions overseeing an attraction operation. A friendly smile and pleasant personality are required as you will be interacting with guests. Your employer may ask you to perform other duties related to your job type. If you have questions or concerns about this, please contact InterExchange.

Additional Description

This job is a fast paced job inside the Casino Pier Arcade where employees are assigned to work either behind the counter in sales, or to work the floor assisting guests with the operation of the arcade games and the Virtual Reality attractions.

Counter Sales - When working behind a counter you will be using a point-of-sale system for guest purchases and redeeming guest's points for prizes. You will be interacting with our guests and therefore must have an outgoing personality and good command of the English language.

Floor Person - When working on the floor, you will be responsible for resolving problems with guests who may experience issues with the operation of the arcade games. The floor person is also responsible for maintaining and replenishing the merchandise in the arcade machines. This may include replenishing prizes, tickets or tokens.
