Position Description

Grocery Clerks are responsible for unloading the grocery truck, parceling out the groceries to the shelves, leveling the grocery shelves and checking for date rotation, putting later expiration dates in the back and closer expiration dates in the front of shelves. You may have to perform these duties for both regular as well as frozen/dairy groceries. Your employer may ask you to perform other duties related to your job type. If you have questions or concerns about this, please contact InterExchange.

Grocery Clerk – Job Description

Departments: Grocery, Produce, Floral, Bakery, Deli, Meat, Seafood, Checkout, eCommerce

Position Summary

Grocery Clerks support supermarket operations by assisting customers, stocking and rotating merchandise, preparing select food products, and maintaining clean, safe, and visually appealing work areas. Clerks may work primarily in one department but assist others as needed.

Students may share department preferences or restrictions during the interview; these will be considered, but final placement is determined by the store at orientation.

General Responsibilities

- Provide friendly, responsive customer service.
- Stock, replenish, and rotate merchandise.
- Maintain cleanliness and sanitation of work areas and equipment.
- Read and enter PLUs, labels, and order information accurately.
- Follow safety, lifting, hygiene, and food-handling standards.
- Communicate professionally with customers and coworkers.
- Work in varying temperature environments.

Department Specific Responsibilities

Grocery

- Stock shelves, dairy, frozen foods, and general merchandise.
- Rotate inventory, remove outdated items, and maintain back-room cleanliness.
- Assist customers and lift cases as needed.

Produce

- Stock produce cases and cull low-quality items.
- Prepare cut fruit, salads, and trim vegetables.
- Maintain clean, appealing displays in cool/damp areas.

Floral

- Stock floral cases and rotate product.
- Prepare simple arrangements, bouquets, balloons, and fruit baskets.
- Assist customers; work in cool/damp areas or outdoors.

Bakery

- Prepare, wrap, label, and price bakery items.
- Set up trays/product for baking.
- Stock displays and maintain sanitation in warm environments.

Deli (No slicer operation)

- Prepare and package hot/cold deli foods.
- Take customer orders and weigh/label items.
- Maintain rotation, quality, and sanitation.

Meat

- Wrap, weigh, label, and stock raw meat products.
- Assist customers at the service counter.
- Work in cold prep/cooler environments.

Seafood

- Weigh, price, and package seafood.
- Replenish ice displays and maintain sanitation.
- Work with cooked, uncooked, and live seafood.

Checkout / Cashier

- Scan items, process payments, and issue receipts.
- Bag groceries and maintain checkout area.
- Retrieve carts and provide attentive service.

eCommerce Shopper

- Use handheld device to select items for online orders.
- Choose quality products and make substitutions.
- Bag, stage, and deliver curbside orders.

Physical Requirements

- Frequent standing, walking, bending, reaching, and repetitive motion.
- Able to push, pull, or more carts or equipment.
- Lift 5–35 lbs. routinely; up to 50–70 lbs. as required.
- Work in warm, cool, cold, damp, or freezer environments.
