

PLEASE NOTE: The standard Housekeeping shift is an AM shift from 8:00am to 4:30pm. Some students may be assigned to a PM Housekeeping Shift (3:00pm to 11:00pm). JOB DUTIES • Clean all assigned units, replenish supplies and linens (does require the use of cleaning chemicals) • Ensure proper use of all equipment and supplies issued • Make all beds and sofa beds cribs etc. when servicing a unit • Replenish supplies such as drinking glasses housewares etc. and writing supplies • Other duties as assigned
