You may not possess firearms or weapons of any kind in housing or surrounding areas at any time. Consuming alcohol on premises or surrounding areas is NOT allowed. Illegal drugs and drug paraphernalia are NOT allowed in rooms or anywhere on property and will result in eviction. Illegal downloading will result in ALL Wi-Fi being shut off. You must stay in your assigned room. Switching rooms without approval can lead to being evicted from housing. You may not use candles, incense or open flame inside your room or housing. Riding electric scooters inside housing will result in a \$25 fine per offense and can lead up to eviction.

## Cleaning Responsibilities

Participants are responsible for cleaning their housing. The supplies provided are a broom and toilet brush. All other supplies should be supplied by participants.
